Local Organizations

Bailey's Crossroads Volunteer Fire Department - Provide financial support for the purchase of equipment and operating expenses for local volunteer fire department.

Bailey's Crossroads Community Shelter - Provide volunteer help, food, toiletries, cold weather clothing, bedding linen, and personal care items and financial support for homeless men and women.

Bethany House - Provide financial support, food and clothing to battered spouses and children.
