Local Organizations

Bailey's Crossroads Volunteer Fire Department – Provide financial support for the purchase of equipment and operating expenses for local volunteer fire department.

Outstanding Educational Leadership Awards – Recognize teachers and other educational leaders who make significant contributions to the education and development of students at all levels.

Community Service

Bailey's Crossroads and Area Food Delivery – Conduct annual social/cultural outreach by providing Thanksgiving food delivery to area needy families involving Elementary and High School students. Provided 20,000 packaged meals for local students.

Community Cleanup Project – As a sponsor organization, participate with community organizations and the local High School Interact Club in the Mason District cleanup project in the Culmore/Bailey's Crossroads communities.

Fairfax County Parks Foundation – Support outreach programs of Hidden Oaks Nature Center and Green Spring Gardens.
