Car History

This Mustang was born on July 12, 1966 at the Dearborn, MI plant and shipped to Stengers Ford in Dayton, OH. The first owner lived in nearby Fairborn, OH and purchased the car in July 1966. The second owner purchased the car in September 1991 and resided in Centerville, OH. The third owner purchased the car in April 1993 and moved the car to Evans, GA. The Rotary Club of Baileys Crossroads purchased the car on September 5, 2017. This Mustang has been restored as GT-Tribute with final restoration completed in March 2019. Repainted and re-badged as a GT-Tribute December 2018, new pony interior in January 2019. The engine is original to the car and was completely rebuilt in March 2019.
